Men's National Tournament - Administrative Rules

- 1. Each team can have a maximum of twelve (12) players on a roster.
- 2. All players must be in issued league uniforms in order to play in a game, no exceptions! No uniform, no play!
- 3. All must be listed in the official scorer's book before the game starts. Any player who come after the game starts, cannot play in the game until after the first half. Any player who arrives after halftime will not be eligible to play in the game.
- 4. Forfeit time is game time! You may start a game with four (4) players. If a team starts a game with four (4) players and multiple players arrives after the start of the game only one player will be allow to enter the after a timeout has been called. All other players that arrive late will be subject to enter the contest at half time.
- 5. Players cannot change teams at any point in the tournament.
- 6. Players cannot substitute players on a roster after tournament rosters have been submitted. Players can be remove from the roster by their respective teams by notifying the tournament Director. Players can also be removed from any team roster at the Tournament Director's discretion, based on infraction for league rules. Any player that been removed from the roster by the team or the tournament staff cannot be replaced.
- 7. All registration funds must be turned it prior to the start of the tournament. The fees are based on Twelve (12) players, can be divided by twelve (12) players. The total amount per team is \$3,200

- 8. All players must sign a facility wavier before playing in the NYCSA Adult Basketball Tournament
- 9. Any team that wants to file a protest can do so, by submitting in writing a formal complaint. Protests can be lodged base on rules infraction, not officials' calls. A \$25 non refundable fee needed to given to the Tournament Director within one hour (1) after the game in question. Protest decision will be made within one (1) hour after the protest has been submitted
- 10. Payouts for the Local & National Championship tournament will be given after the championship games. All funds will be given will directly to each player in a form of a cashier's check that will be presented after each tournament.
- 11. The NYCSA will pay for travel and lodging for the National Championship Tournament. Meals are the responsibility of each team that make the National tournament.
